## Start at the Tourism Office

The Tourism Office is in a special house which is called the Maison (1) \_\_\_\_\_



Some **mascarons\*** and **animal's heads** decorated the Tourism Office facade, name animals find the face who stick out his tongue (2) \_\_\_\_\_

*\*A mascaron ornament is a face, usually human, sometimes frightening or chimeric whose function was originally to frighten away evil spirits so that they would not enter the building.*

## The Slogan of Arnay-le-Duc

You can see the blazon of Arnay-le-Duc on each part of the clock. He represents **3 entrance doors of the town** which date of the Middle Ages.

« Clear Blue sky with crenellated and covered of silver towers, golden entrances, opened, masoned with lime plaster, the one in the center uppermost. »

This sculpture is dedicated to the museum and table art, find the 3 symbols of taste and cooking (19)

When you have found all details, go back to the Bakery and find this street:

Continue in this street. You are near Place du Craquelin. Find the house with this memorial plaque:

*Did you find all the answers?  
Go back to the Tourism Office to claim them and you will receive a reward...*

Then, go to the paved alley near the Tower.  
 Turn on your right, then on your left in Rue César Lavirotte,  
 in direction of Maison Régionale des Arts de la Table.



Take a short pause near the bakery and consider the distance. There is **la Chapelle Contaut**, this is where the battle of Arnay took place on June 27th 1570, in which Henri de Navarre, future

king of France, took part. Henri de Navarre is also known by another name. Which? (16)



Stay on the left, go down the road to the **Maison Régionale des Arts de la Table**, former Hospices Saint Pierre of Beaune. Now, this is a museum dedicated to table arts. What is the theme of the exhibition? (17)



(Don't hesitate to entry in the museum to ask the theme and see the chapel and the little shop ...).

Find the sculpture, go right around it and find the **3 animals** hidden on it.

The 1st, a small reptile that hides in walls, the 2nd is something we eat in France (and particularly in Burgundy), and the 3<sup>rd</sup>, much bigger than the others, went through Arnay on June 18th 1827 on its way to Paris. (18)



### Rue Saint-Honoré

Go into the direction of Café du Nord, then the street on your right. Find the oldest house of Arnay-Le-Duc. What was sold here? (6)



### Parking Saint Honoré

Find something to know what time is it? So what time is it? (7)

### Rue Jacob

Go to the bottom of the parking, down to the porch. This is Rue Jacob. Find this sculpture. What is it ? (8)



Up Rue Jacob and go straight ahead to the paved small alley.

At the end of this alley, you will see a big tower. It's the Tour de la Lanterne but there's another name (pictures helped you)



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Did you know that there are many towers in Arnay? Round towers, square towers, barbicans\*, **there are about 30 of them!!!** (\*tower which sticks out sideways)

Keep going straight on. At the end of the paved path turn left. You'll find yourself in front of the castle. (10)

And today it's a center for Professional Education (CPE).



From 1865 to 1954, the castle was occupied by a **file factory**. Metal files from 3 to 60cm were made here, these were used by jewelers, engravers, sculptors, clock makers, as well as dentists. They were hewed by hand. About **400 workers** were employed here.

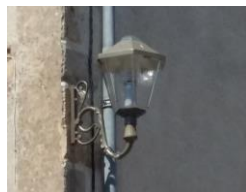
**Today there is nothing left of this file factory in the castle** except a medallion with 3 initials.

Where is this medallion and what are the 3 letters? (11)

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Go down Castle road (rue du Château), and follow the clues to find **the Lime Tree**.



take a right into Rue des Ursulines.

**Go right up to the lime tree.** It was planted in 1848.

How old is it? (12) -----



Go towards the ancient porch and try and find what is it; keep your head up!! (13)

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Go back the way you came and go towards Rue de l'église

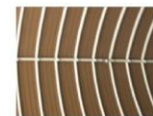
### The Church (14)
